Putting trees or shrubs in random places may look good at first, but plants grow, and if they aren't spaced out properly, they will crowd each other out. Over time, roots or branches that are too long can hurt walkways, siding, or fences. A detailed landscape plan makes sure that everything is in balance, symmetrical, and has room to grow.

3. Giving too much or too little water

Both can be just as bad. A lot of people in Ankeny think that watering every day is best, but too much water can kill roots.
